Relaxation procedures, flooding, systematic desensitization therapy, EMDR, Cognitive Therapy, Cognitive Behaviour Therapy, Client centre therapy, Family Therapy.

Internship

Every enrolled student will be required to work in hospital, school, NGO and counselling setting.
