1. M. Phil in Clinical Psychology...... 10 seats

Aim:- The aim of this course is to prepare the trainee to function as a qualified professional Clinical Psychologist in the areas of mental and physical health by offering Diagnostic, Therapeutic, Rehabilitative, Administrative services, and to work towards promoting the well-being and quality-of-life of individuals.

Eligibility Criteria:- Candidate to be eligible to appear for M. Phil in Clinical Psychology entrance test, should have passed as Master's Degree of psychology any recognized University with at least 55% marks (In case of SC/ST/OBC, 50% minimum).

Duration of course:- Minimum duration is 2 years (Divided as Part-I and Part-II). It is a full time clinical training course.

Aim:- The aim of this course is to build capacity of the students in psychiatric social work that would enable them to work with persons with mental illness, their family members/ care offers and other stakeholders such as employers, educators, neighbor hood/ community.

Eligibility Criteria:- Candidate to be eligible to appear for M. Phil in Psychiatric Social Work entrance test, should have passed as Master's Degree of Social Work from any recognized University with at least 55% marks (In case of SC/ST/OBC, 50% minimum).

Duration of course:- Minimum duration is 2 years (Divided as Part-I and Part-II). It is a full time clinical training course.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Incomplete application form will not be entertained.

2. The candidates must produce original copies of all certificates, mark sheets, testimonials, caste certificate/residential/disability certificate if applicable etc. and other relevant documents at the time of Interview/Counselling.

3. The Institute will not provide accommodation for the purpose of entrance examination.

4. No TA/DA will be provided to the applicants / accompanying members by the Institute to appear in the entrance examination.

5. Bring Blue / Black Ball Pen to fill the circle provided on the OMR sheet.

6. Question booklet will consist of hundred multiple-choice type questions based on prescribed syllabus at PG level of University at National level.

- **7.** Entry in examination hall is prohibited without a valid Admit Card that will be provided after scrutiny of application form and fulfilling eligibility criteria.Admit card will be provide 7 days before examination.
- **8.** Candidate should enter into the examination hall half an hour before the commencement of examination.
- **9.** Candidates are not allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of specified time.

10. Candidates are not allowed to carry any electronics gazette inside examination hall.

11. Candidates must follow the instructions given by the Invigilators.

12. 2 (two) marks will be awarded for each correct answer and 1 (one) mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

13. Practical examination on the day of interview (Practical/Viva-voice) is mandatory as per Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) norms for all the candidates after qualifying the written examination.

14. Final selection of the candidates will be done on merit basis as per the performance in entrance examination and interview (Practical/Viva-voice).
15. M.A/M.Sc in Psychology/Clinical Psychology who recently pass out in 2022, & their final mark sheet will not displayed at the time of Entrance Exam.They must bring provisional mark sheet attested by HOD at the time of Interview.

DEPARTMENT OF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

The Department of Clinical Psychology was established in the year 2007 at Central India Institute of Mental Health and Neuro-Sciences under the guidance of Dr. Pramod R Gupta (Director & Psychiatrist). The department help people who are struggling with mental, emotional, social, and behavioural disorders by applying their extensive knowledge and expertise in assessment, diagnosis, treatment, teaching, research and prevention. The department was started the M. Phil in Clinical Psychology course in the year of 2021 at Central India Institute and recognized by Rehabilitation Council of India (with intake of 10 students per batch) and also internship courses for clinical psychology students started.





Clinical services:

Clinical psychologists take detail psychological assessments of the patients At times, clinical psychologists use answers from patients to evaluate problems that are confusing or worrying, offering alternative ways of interpreting and understanding them through the psychodiagnostic assessments (projective tests, and objective testing like MPQ, MMPI, MCMI TCI etc) aptitude testing, neuropsychological assessments, training for basic managerial skills and all kind of psychotherapeutic management including CBT, REBT, MBCBT, RPT, DBT, IPSRT and general counselling etc.

Departmental activities:

The Department of Clinical Psychology has well trained and qualified faculty members. The departmental conducts regular academic classes and weekly departmental seminars and psychotherapy meetings based on the course curriculum for the students as well as for students of other disciplines such as Psychiatric Social Work and Psychiatric Nursing. The trainees are required to present and participate in departmental case conferences, seminars and journal clubs.

Laboratory

The department has well- equipped psychological assessment infrastructure to facilitate better mental health services and training mental health professionals. The laboratory is well stacked with various tests for assessment of personality(MMPI-II, Rorschach Inkblot Test, EPQ, CPQ,RPFT,MCMI-III, CAT, TAT & etc), Neuropsychological testing (N-FAB, PGI-BBD, Raven's Progressive Matrices, AIIMS Battery BGT-II and etc.), and other domains of human behaviour (MISIC, DST, WAIPIS, WAIS-IV, SBIS, various screening test learning disorders and etc).



DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRIC SOCIAL WORK

The department of psychiatric social work was established in the year 2007 at Central India Institute of Mental Health and Neuro-Sciences under the guidance of Dr. Pramod R Gupta (Director & Psychiatrist). The department seeks to enhance the social functioning of individuals, singly and in groups, by activities focused upon their social relationships which constitute the interaction between man and his environment. The department was started the M.Phil in psychiatric social work course in the year of 2021 at this institute and affiliated by Hemchand Yadav University, Durg (with intake of 30 students per batch).



Clinical services:

The department take detail case workup and psychosocial assessments of the patients At times. They may perform psychotherapy and even diagnose mental illness. Psychiatric social worker evaluates the root of the patient's problems and provide to individual counselling, insight to integrate cognitive, behavior modification, group therapy, marital therapy, family therapy and etc and also providing communication and links to hospitals and community resources.



Departmental activities:

The Department has well trained and qualified faculty members. The departmental conducts regular academic classes and weekly departmental seminars and psychotherapy meetings based on the course curriculum for the students as well as for students. The trainees are required to present and participate in departmental case conferences, seminars and journal clubs. The students are also given ample privileges and opportunities to develop their clinical and academic skills. They learn to dispense family and community based therapeutic services for people with mental illnesses under the direct supervision of the faculty.
